
**DISMISSAL PRIOR TO INDICTMENT**

COMES NOW the State of Georgia, by and through Deborah Gonzalez, District Attorney, and prior to indictment, hereby dismisses the above-referenced charges for the following reasons:

Georgia Code 17.3.1e states "Prosecution for misdemeanors shall be commenced within two years after the commission of the crime". Although there is sufficient evidence to prosecute this case, the State has not accused or indicted the case referenced above within two years from the date of the offense, September 21, 2019. At this time, the State must dismiss the case referenced.

WHEREFORE, the State hereby DISMISSES the above-referenced warrant and charges prior to indictment.
