PLEA IN BAR

COMES NOW, Defendant and files this Plea in Bar and in support thereof shows
the Court as follows:

1.

On January 4, 2022, Defendant was indicted by the Grand Jury on 13 counts.
Counts 11 through 13 accuse Defendant of, respectively: Driving Under the Influence
(Controlled Substance), Driving Under the Influence (Less Safe-Drugs), and Failure to
Maintain Lane. The offenses alleged in Counts 11, 12, and 13 are misdemeanors.

2.

The Indictment alleges that these misdemeanor offenses were committed on
February 11, 2018.

3.

“Prosecutions for misdemeanors must be commenced within two years after the
commission of the crime.” O.C.G.A. § 17-3-1 (e).

4.

Because the misdemeanor offenses in Counts 11-13 were accused by indictment more than two years after the alleged date of commission, they are barred by the statute of limitations. O.C.G.A. § 17-3-1(e).

WHEREFORE, the Defendant Jabbary Stevens respectfully requests that the Court dismiss the offenses alleged in Counts 11, 12, and 13.
